




ISSUED BUILDING PERMITS AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BUILDINGS STARTED IN THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2021

In the second quarter of 2021, the municipal authorities issued **building permits** for the construction of 1 745 residential buildings with 9 952 dwellings and 1 181 550 sq. m gross building area, 26 administrative buildings/offices with 44 889 sq. m gross building area and 1 214 other buildings with 448 862 sq. m gross building area.

As compared to the previous quarter, the issued building permits for residential buildings increased by 12.9%, their dwellings - by 13.4%, as well as their gross building area - by 14.9%. The issued building permits for administrative buildings shown decrease by 7.1% and their gross building area - by 51.8%. Issued building permits for other buildings went up by 8.7%, while their gross building area fell by 22.6%.

Figure 1. Building permits, issued for construction of new buildings by type and quarter








As compared to the second quarter of 2020 the issued building permits for new residential buildings increased by 28.1%, their dwellings - by 67.9% and the gross building area - by 43.5%. Permits were issued for 16.1% fewer administrative buildings, with 144.9% larger gross building area. The issued building permits for other buildings rose by 29.8%, as well as their gross building area - by 5.0%.

The highest number of building permits for new residential buildings was issued in the following districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 269, Plovdiv - 243, Sofia - 204, Varna - 124 and Burgas - 118. Most dwellings are to be built in the districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 5 367, Plovdiv - 1 056, Varna - 665, Burgas - 435 and Kardzhali - 390 (Annex, Table 1).





In the second quarter of 2021 **began the construction** of 1 410 residential buildings with 5 993 dwellings and 784 124 sq. m gross building area, of 21 administrative buildings/offices with 19 915 sq. m gross building area and 642 other buildings with 419 529 sq. m gross building area.

As compared to the previous quarter, the started residential buildings increased by 41.3%, their dwellings - by 13.1%, as well as the gross building area - by 18.7%. The started administrative buildings and their gross building area registered a growth respectively twice and nearly four times. The started other buildings rose by 11.5%, with 20.8% growth in their gross building area.





Figure 3. Started construction of new buildings by type and quarter

As compared to the second quarter of 2020, the started new residential buildings increased by 44.0%, their dwellings - by 25.7%, as well as the gross building area - by 26.0%. The number of started administrative buildings was no change, but their gross building area fell by 25.8%. The started other buildings rose by 9.9%, and their gross building area - by 42.7%.

The construction of the highest number of new buildings was started in the following districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 260 residential buildings, 8 administrative buildings and 34 other buildings; Plovdiv - 231 residential buildings, 3 administrative buildings and 65 other buildings; Sofia - 148 residential buildings and 41 other buildings; Varna - 136 residential buildings and 30 other buildings; Burgas - 88 residential buildings and 32 other buildings (Annex, Table 2).





Methodological notes

The quarterly statistical survey of permits issued for construction collects information about building permits, issued by municipal authorities as well as for the started construction of new buildings according to their type and gross building area. This information may be used as an indicator of the future construction activity of enterprises in the country.

Type of buildings is classified according to the Classification of types of construction (CC) and is divided into:

- Residential buildings for which the useful floor area is mostly used for permanent residential habitation.
- Non-residential buildings for various purposes, including:
- administrative offices and buildings for administrative work of departments and other organizations and associations (representative buildings banks, post offices, government department offices, conference and congress centres, low courts, municipalities);
- other buildings buildings used for different activities: production, trade, transport, education, cultural, sports, agriculture, health, recreation and facilities for a short stay (hotels, motels, rest houses, huts and others).

Gross building area - a sum of all floors areas in external dimensions.
